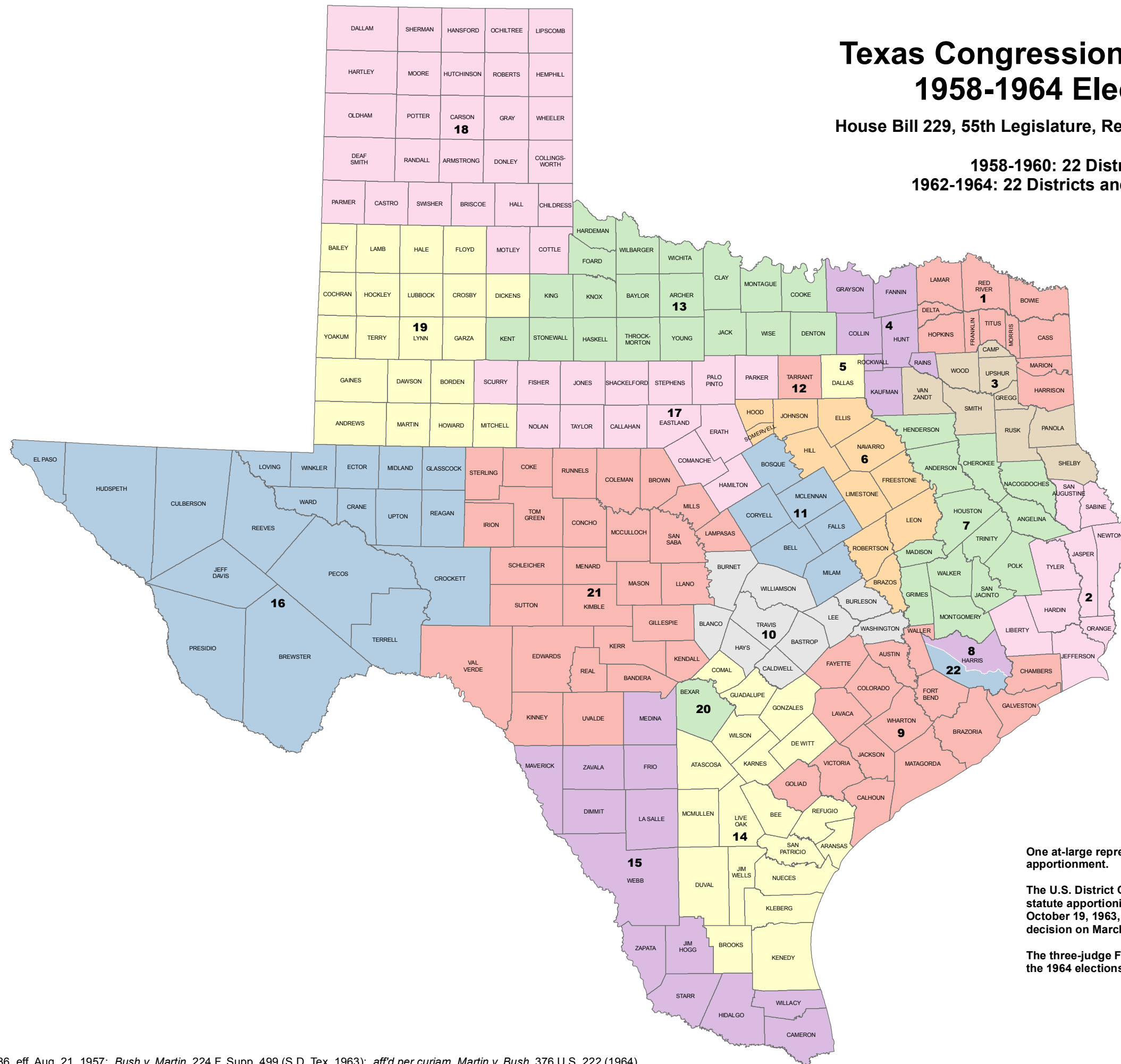


Texas Congressional Districts 1958-1964 Elections

House Bill 229, 55th Legislature, Regular Session (1957)

1958-1960: 22 Districts
1962-1964: 22 Districts and 1 At-large



One at-large representative was added after the 1960 Census and subsequent apportionment.

The U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Texas held that the Texas statute apportioning congressional districts was unconstitutional on October 19, 1963, *Bush v. Martin*. The U.S. Supreme Court affirmed the decision on March 2, 1964, *Martin v. Bush*.

The three-judge Federal District Court allowed the districts to be used for the 1964 elections.
